- All Contractors which secure a place on the Framework will be required to subscribe to the Exor accreditation service Gold standard or greater, or provide equal and equivalent accreditation.
- Organisations currently possessing EXOR Gold accreditation may be exempted from completing one section of the PQQ.



Framework Duration

- The Framework Agreement is intended to operate for 4 years from June 2009.

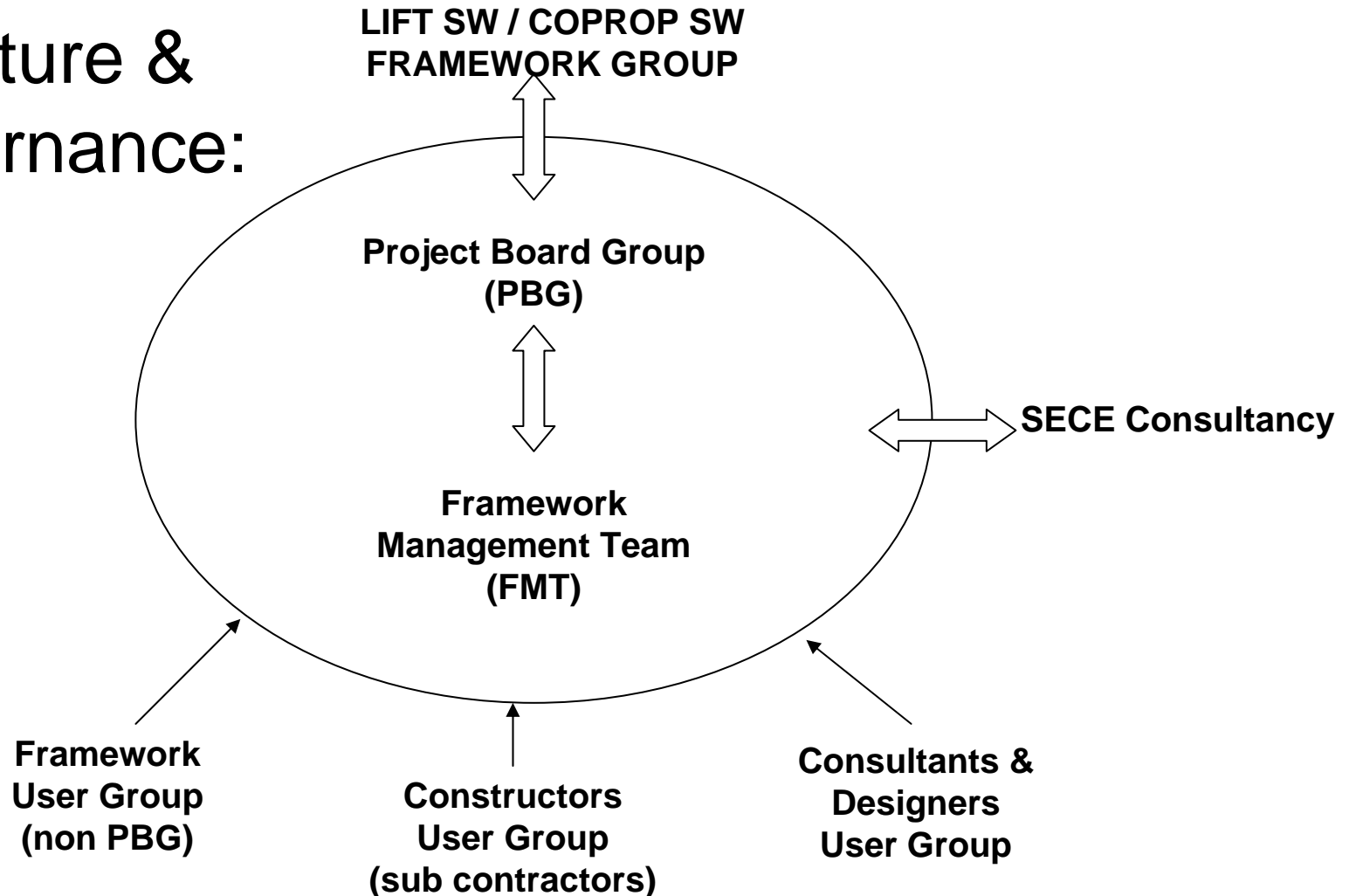
(There will be a break clause at 2 years which will only be used in extremis)
